Beaumont Hospital has a very active summer externship program, offering its many externship positions preferentially to Wayne State University's first-year students. All externships for 2010 will be **six weeks in length: June 7 to July 16**. A **\$1500 stipend** will be paid to each extern completing the program.

30 externships will be offered, with the following likely participating departments:

Students will be able to choose experiences focusing on **clinical/patient care, clinical research, or basic science research**. All externs will have the opportunity to interact closely not only with their faculty mentors, but also with our many residents and fellows.

William Beaumont Hospital — Grosse Pointe

Overview:

William Beaumont Hospital - Grosse Pointe Summer Externship program offers 2-4 positions preferentially to Wayne State University's first year students who have recently completed their first year of medical school. It is a six week program which begins mid-June and ends the third week of July. In 2010, the program will run from June 14 through July 23.

Students are introduced to various clinical specialties including:

Family Medicine
General Surgery
Emergency Medicine
Radiology
Pathology

Students become acquainted with various departments such as cardiopulmonary, physical therapy, and speech pathology where they observe EKG's stress tests, speech evaluations and other diagnostic test being performed.

Lectures are held weekly and cover such topics as lab findings, x-rays, and the physical examination. In addition, an orientation to emergencies lecture series is held during the month of July which the students are encouraged to attend.

Our goal is to expose the students with an opportunity to explore their interests in the various specialties of medicine.
